AVEDIS is a member of a consortium led by EPOS Health Consultants that has been awarded the contract to implement the "Multi-sectoral response to HIV&AIDS" project in Namibia funded by GTZ. The project will run from February 2009 to May 2011 and has a total contract volume of €1.4m. Namibia has one of the highest HIV prevalence rates in Africa, currently standing at 15.3%. The project supports the Namibian government and its decentralised administrative and political structures in implementing its national strategy. The overall goal of the projects is to enable the partners in the Northern region, which is hardest hit by the epidemic, to react in a systematic and effective way to the causes and impacts of HI&AIDS. To achieve this overall goal, the consortium has deployed five long-term experts who will act as Technical Advisors to the National Ministry of Local Government, Housing and Rural Development (MoLGHRD) and to the regional multi-sectoral teams that are in charge of identifying and coordinating local responses to HIV&AIDS.
